### What is Weatherization?

Weatherization is the process by which homes are made more energy efficient through a series of energy conservation measures.

### What is a Weatherization Technician?

A Weatherization Technician is a person who performs weatherization and repair activities necessary to make a home more energy efficient. The work typically includes installation of weather stripping, caulking, insulation, duct wrapping, water heater blankets, and miscellaneous air leakage repairs.
